## Annapolis County Parks, Trails & Open Spaces

This popular brochure includes a map and 40 outdoor adventures. Whether you walk, jog, hike, cycle, paddle, bird watch, garden, fish, cross country ski or enjoy traveling by car, the diverse landscape with its scenic vistas, parks, trails and beautiful sunsets will inspire you.

## Delap's Cove Wilderness Trail

Stroll through the lush forest and emerge for a breath of salt air on the rugged, windswept coastline of the Bay of Fundy. This is a nature lover and photographer's paradise. Interpretation sites and picnic areas offer opportunities for both an educational and pleasurable wilderness adventure. Approx. 24 km (15 miles) northwest of Annapolis, Delaps Cove has two wilderness trails – Bohaker and Charlie's – each with its own unique ecosystem. The abandoned Old Shore Rd. links them. Bohaker Trail has a magnificent waterfall.

## Raven Haven Beachside Family Park

Raven Haven, open June 9 - Sept. 6, is a 4-acre family-oriented park on the scenic shores of nearby Sandy Bottom Lake, owned by the Municipality of Annapolis County, managed by Recreation Services. Reservations recommended for campsites, cabins and hostel. Qualified lifeguards supervise swimmers daily 11 am - 7 pm. The first Anglican Church Service in Canada was held in Annapolis Royal when the French garrison surrendered the fort to the British for the last time in October of 1710. Commemorate 300 years (1710 - 2010) of continuous Parish ministry in the Anglican Church of Canada at St. Luke's with unique worship services, a special music series, drama and tours during July and August. The Historic Worship Services will feature music and readings typical of the various eras. The 21st Century Youth Service will also include an old-fashioned picnic, sack races and fun games galore.
