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The Fort Anne Heritage Tapestry, designed by Kiyoko Grenier-Sago, was stitched by over 100 volunteers.

## Fort Anne Tapestry

Fort Anne's Heritage Tapestry depicts 4 centuries of history in three million delicate needlepoint stitches. Stitched in 95 colours of wool, it measures about 18' in length and 8' in height, and was a labor of love over 4 years in the making. It is a unique work of immense proportions, but Annapolis Royal is a community with an epic story to relate.

Explore the "Cradle of Acadie" with 10th generation Acadian Métis Alan Melanson (of Candlelight Graveyard Tour fame). Enjoy music, dance, stories and learn about making rappie pie.
